Double Vaccination Verification Procedure

The Province of Ontario has mandated that as of 22 September 2021, all patrons entering bars and restaurants, which will include the Byron-Springbank Legion, must show proof of double vaccination.

When entering the Clubroom, all members and guests, will be asked by the bartender to show your Dose Administration Receipt from your second vaccination shot and a piece of Photo Id. Until the Province releases it's Vaccine Passport phone application, this is the only way of verifying that you have been double vaccinated.

If you do not have a copy of your Dose Administration Receipt,

- Go to <https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/>
- Scroll down to "Terms of Use"
- click the box beside "I have read and understood the terms of use"
- the Continue button will be activated click on it and it will take to the page to enter your Information

Sometime around mid-October, the Province will supply every Ontarian with a QR Code. This will be either on your phone or you should be able to request it in hard copy. Once the Vaccine Passport App is available, the bartender will be able to scan your QR Code and his phone will show a green checkmark or a red X.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THIS IS NOT THE BRANCH'S CHOICE. TO STAY OPEN, WE MUST COMPLY WITH THE PROVINCE'S RULE. THEREFORE, DO NOT COMPLAIN OR HARASS THE BARTENDER FOR ENFORCING THE PROCEDURE.

Any harassment or failure to comply, will be dealt with through the Royal Canadian Legion's disciplinary procedure.

Please be patient until we iron any kinks out of the procedure.
